About my eventual talk:

Lower limb reconstruction after sarcoma resection is one of the greatest challenges in contemporary orthopaedic and reconstructive surgery. In our presentation at Euromicro 2026, we will address the continuum of treatment: from oncological planning and obtaining clear margins, through limb preservation (limb-salvage) versus amputation options, to advanced reconstructive techniques — local and free flaps, vascularised bone grafts, customised endoprosthetic arthroplasty, and integration of 3D solutions and virtual planning. Patient selection criteria, strategies to minimise complications (infection, necrosis, graft loss), and early integration of rehabilitation to optimise final function and quality of life will be discussed.
