

He was born in Timișoara (Romania) in 1975 and completed his undergraduate medical training at the Victor Babeș University of Medicine and Pharmacy in the same city. In 2003, he obtained his medical doctorate (MD) at Ruprecht Karls University Heidelberg. He achieved board certification in Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery in 2007 and has been working in Germany as a board-certified Plastic, Reconstructive, and Hand Surgeon since 2013.

Since 2017, he has served as Director of the Department of Plastic, Reconstructive and Hand Surgery at the Evangelisches Krankenhaus, Medical Campus University of Oldenburg, with a strong clinical and academic focus on advanced reconstructive microsurgery. His areas of particular expertise include microsurgical bone transfer at the wrist, orthoplastic and vasculoplastic limb salvage, as well as lymphatic surgery from lymph node transfer to supramicrosurgical derivative procedures.

In addition, since 2017 he has been Director and Program Coordinator of the Oldenburg–Groningen Advanced Training Program in Reconstructive Microsurgery, an internationally recognized educational platform endorsed by the European Federation of Societies for Microsurgery (EFSM) and the World Society for Reconstructive Microsurgery (WSRM).
